MULTI-REGIONAL

Maximising the Quality of Scaling up Nutrition Programmes Framework Agreement (MQSUN): (2012-2016, DFID/HPI) HPI provides DFID and members of the Scaling Up Nutrition movement with technical services to improve the quality of nutrition-specific and nutrition-sensitive programmes in DFID priority countries.

Evaluation of the Health Partnership Scheme: (2016, DFID GEFA/THET) HPI provides technical support to assess the impact and effectiveness of DFID's global Health Partnership Scheme programme.

Evaluation of Safe Abortion Action Fund: WISE is conducting a performance evaluation of the SAAF (2015-2017, IPPF) across Pakistan, Peru, Lebanon, Ghana and Uganda.

Evaluation of Increasing Accountability in Financing for Gender Equality (F4GE): The Evaluation (2015-2016, UNW/ISG Solutions) addresses the five criteria of relevance, efficiency, effectiveness, sustainability, and impact. WISE is documenting lessons learned and best practices and providing recommendations to inform future work on financing for gender equality.

Innovation Knowledge exchange Facility (IKEF): HPI provides technical support to the evaluation of proposed health innovations as part of the Innovation Knowledge Exchange Facility (2016-2017, DFID/IMC Worldwide) which aims to drive inclusive innovation through south-south learning, partnerships and technology transfer.

WEST AFRICA

NIGERIA

Women for Health (W4H): HPI leads the Women for Health programme (2012-2017, DFID/HPI), addressing the acute shortage of female health workers and issues around increasing recruitment and retention in rural areas in five states in the North.

Support to National Malaria Programme (SuMaP): (2008-2016, DFID/Malaria Consortium) HPI supports and strengthens delivery of the Nigerian National Malaria Elimination Programme by improving National, State and Local Government Area capacity for policy development, planning and coordination.

EU Support to Immunisation Governance (EU-SIGN): HPI supports the EU Support to Immunisation Governance (2014-2017, EU/Conseil Santé) programme by strengthening the governance of routine immunisation at Federal level and across 23 States to improve maternal, newborn and child health.

Integrated Approach to Neglected Tropical Diseases (UNITED): (2013-2017, DFID/Sightsavers) assists the government in controlling seven neglected tropical diseases. HPI is responsible for ensuring effective coordination across the health system.

Propcom Maikarfi: (2015-2016 DFID/Palladium) WISE supports the integration of gender equality and women's economic empowerment strategies in increasing employment opportunities in agricultural and rural markets for the poor.

Girls Education Programme 3 (GEP3): (2015-2016, UNICEF/EDOREN/OPM) GEP 3 provides a package of interventions to improve access, retention and quality to girls' education. WISE leads the baseline research focusing on an integrated Quranic Schooling Approach within GEP3 through a qualitative case study approach that seeks to test and track the assumptions within the programme's theory of change.

Growth Employment Markets in States 4 (GEMS4): (2015-2016, DFID/Coffey) GEMS 4 is a national project aimed at job creation and increased non-oil growth in specific high potential value chain sectors. WISE is developing a gender policy relevant to the wholesale and retail sector and provides capacity strengthening for the national programme team.

GHANA

Market Development for Northern Ghana (MADE): (2016-2017, DFID/Nathan Associates) is expected to improve the incomes and resilience of poor farmers and small-scale rural entrepreneurs by improving the way that markets work, with a focus on agricultural sectors. WISE is supporting MADE's commitment to a more transformative approach which specifically aims to enable women's economic empowerment.
