

# **Directions to HPI**

## By foot from Lewes train station – 10 to 15 minutes

Leaving Lewes train station via the main entrance, turn right. Head north up the hill onto Station Street. Turn right at the top of the hill onto the High Street. Follow the road to the left onto Market Street and follow this all the way down onto North Street round to the left at the bottom of the hill.

The Waterside Business Centre is on the left. Go through the lobby and up the stairs and turn left. Go through the door and our office is on the left, just after the toilets.

If you get lost at any stage, do call the office on 01273 477474. If the weather is awful a taxi from the station will cost under  $\pounds 5$ .

## By car

Our office is located in the Waterside Business Centre on North Street, a short distance from the centre of Lewes. There is limited parking available in the Waterside Business Centre. However, there is also parking on the left after the Fire Station before you reach the Business Centre for about £2 for the day.

#### From the North

# From London

Take the M23/A23 towards Brighton. Before you reach Brighton town centre, take the A27 eastbound which is signposted to Lewes. Stay on this road until you reach a roundabout and take the first exit onto the A275/Brighton Road heading to Haywards Health/Lewes/Kingston. Cross straight over at the traffic lights and follow the A277/Western Road. At the War Memorial take the left where Barclays Bank is, onto the A2029/Market Street. Continue onto North Street round to the left and the Waterside Business Centre is at the end of the road on the left.

# From Haywards Heath

Head southeast on the A272. Turn right onto the A275 and follow this road to the outskirts of Lewes. Then turn left onto the A2029/Offham Road. Turn left at St. John's Terrace. Continue on St. John's Hill. Turn right at Brook Street. Turn left at North Street. The Waterside Business Centre is at the end of the road on the left.

#### From East Grinstead

Follow the A22 from East Grinstead and go straight through three roundabouts. Turn right at Wych Cross onto the A275, and turn right onto the A272 and left onto the A275 again. Then turn left onto the A2029/Offham Road. Turn left at St. John's Terrace. Continue along St. John's Hill. Turn right at Brook Street. Turn left at North Street. The Waterside Business Centre is at the end of the road on the left.

#### From Tunbridge Wells

Follow the A26 from Tunbridge Wells until Black Down roundabout. Take the first exit onto the A22. At the Little Horsted roundabout take the third exit onto the A26 and follow this road into Lewes. Turn left at the A2029/Eastgate Street. Turn right at the A2029/East Street. Turn right onto North Street. The Waterside Business Centre is at the end of the road on the left.

#### From the West

#### From Worthing

Follow the signs out of Worthing for the A27. Take the A27 eastbound which is signposted to Lewes. Stay on this road until you reach a roundabout and take the first exit onto the A275/Brighton Road. Cross straight over at the traffic lights and follow the A277/Western Road. At the War Memorial take the left where Barclays Bank is, onto the A2029/Market Street. Continue onto North Street round to the left and the Waterside Business Centre is at the end of the road on the left.

#### From Brighton

Follow the signs out of Brighton for the A27. Take the A27 eastbound which is signposted to Lewes. Stay on this road until you reach a roundabout and take the first exit onto the A275/Brighton Road. Cross straight over at the traffic lights and follow the A277/Western Road. At the War Memorial take the left where Barclays Bank is, onto the A2029/Market Street. Continue onto North Street round to the left and the Waterside Business Centre is at the end of the road on the left.

#### From the East

## From Eastbourne

Follow the A2270/Willingdon Road out of Eastbourne. At the junction with the A27 turn left. Follow the A27 westbound, which is signposted to Lewes. Stay on this road until the A26 roundabout. Take the second exit onto the A26. Drive through the Cuifail Tunnel and onto Malling Street. Turn left at the A2029/Eastgate Street. Turn right at the A2029/East Street. Turn right onto North Street. The Waterside Business Centre is at the end of the road on the left.

#### From the South

#### From Newhaven

Follow the A26 out of Newhaven signposted towards Lewes. Stay on this road until the A27 roundabout. Take the first exit onto the A27. Stay on this road until the A26 roundabout. Take the second exit onto the A26. Drive through the Cuifail Tunnel and onto Malling Street. Turn left at the A2029/Eastgate Street. Turn right at the A2029/East Street. Turn right onto North Street. The Waterside Business Centre is at the end of the road on the left.

# By air

**London Gatwick** is the closest airport to the HPI offices and has good transport links to Lewes. However, Lewes is also accessible from London Heathrow.

## By road from Gatwick

Follow the signs for the M23 and then follow the directions from London and the North provided above.

## By train from Gatwick

Trains run directly from Gatwick Airport to Lewes station.

# By road from Heathrow

Follow the signs for the M25 and Gatwick Airport. Follow the M25 anticlockwise until the M23 Junction 7 exit. Then follow the directions from London and the North provided above.

## By train from Heathrow

Take the Underground to Victoria Railway Station, from where you can take a direct train to Lewes station.

There is also a coach shuttle service between Heathrow and Gatwick airports.

## By sea

Passenger ferries operate between Dieppe and Newhaven, which has a direct train link to Lewes.

## Via the Channel Tunnel

If you are using Eurostar from continental Europe via the Channel Tunnel it is easiest to disembark at Kings Cross St Pancras. From St Pancras take a First Capital Connect train to East Croydon, where you need to change for a direct Southern train to Lewes.

# By train from London

Take the train from Victoria Railway Station from where you can take a direct train to Lewes train station.
